for the school uniform is...

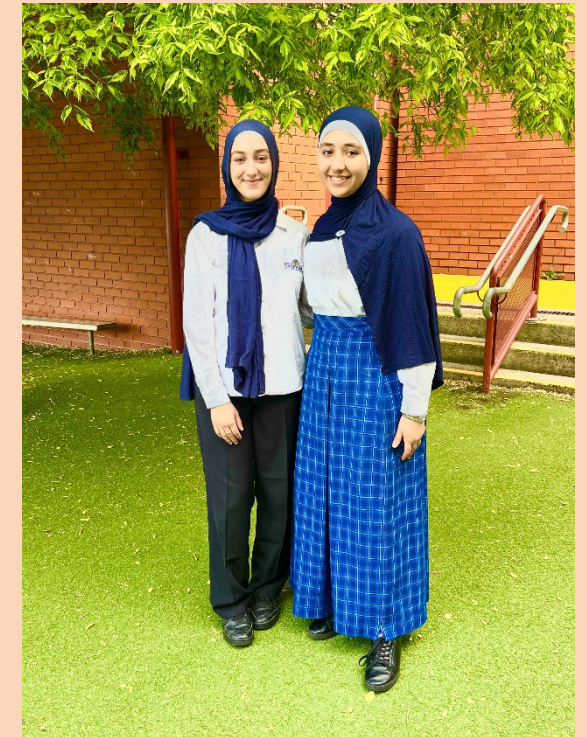
**‘wear it with pride’**

**Please remember:**

Our school uniform is the result of broad consultation with our school community and is **COMPULSORY** at Bankstown Girls High School.

It **reflects** our whole **school community values** which include high expectations, Respect and Readiness for learning and Responsibility.





# Remember...

Minimal jewellery may be worn at school i.e. sleepers or plain stud earrings, a simple gold or silver necklace and a watch

Either a long sleeve or short sleeve white school shirt is to be worn.

Long sleeve undergarments with a school short sleeve shirt are not permitted.

No excessive make-up (lipstick, foundation, blush, mascara, eye shadow, false eyelashes etc) is permitted.

No false nails.

Only navy-blue hijab with white under scarf is to be worn.

Coloured scarves, gloves, hoodies etc are not permitted and will be confiscated.

Short ankle white socks are permitted without logos.

Blue or black tights permitted with school skirt.

Skirts are to be worn at the correct length at knee level.

## Bankstown Girls High School Uniform

<b>Overblouse</b>	White short sleeved or long-sleeved shirt with school logo
<b>Skirt - Junior</b>	White blue check skirt with pleats at the front. Pleats should not be adjusted.
<b>Skirt - Senior</b>	Navy blue with pleats.
<b>Jumper</b>	Navy V-neck woollen jumper with the school logo. Fleecy jumper with school logo.
<b>Shoes</b>	School shoes which are flat, plain black leather and lace up. For safety purposes, they should cover the top of the foot. Boots are not acceptable.
<b>Hijab</b>	Navy-blue hijab.
<b>School pants</b>	Navy blue straight leg cotton blend pants only. No tights or leggings



- The school polo shirt and school navy shorts or track suit must be worn during PE and sports lessons. Sports shoes must also be worn. Students are encouraged to wear sunscreen when participating in outdoor activities.
- Students must carry their sports gear and change at school for PE practical lessons.

## Important Note Regarding Shoes

- Black leather shoes are a very important part of the school uniform and in accordance with Work Health & Safety Requirements.
- They must be worn at all times.
- Canvas shoes are not permitted.



# Procedures for students out of uniform

1

If a student arrives at school out of uniform, they must see a member of the Senior Executive (Deputy Principals) with a parent/carer note.

2

If the reason is valid, an orange uniform note is issued to the student. This incident is entered on Sentral.

3

The student must see the member of the Senior Executive who has issued the note in the correct school uniform on day when the note expires.

4

In the first instance, the parent will be advised to bring the correct item/s of uniform to school. Alternatively, the student will be loaned a second-hand item and must return the washed uniform to the Senior Executive/SASS person who has loaned them the uniform. The student will be issued a recess detention; for repeat offenders, an after-school detention.

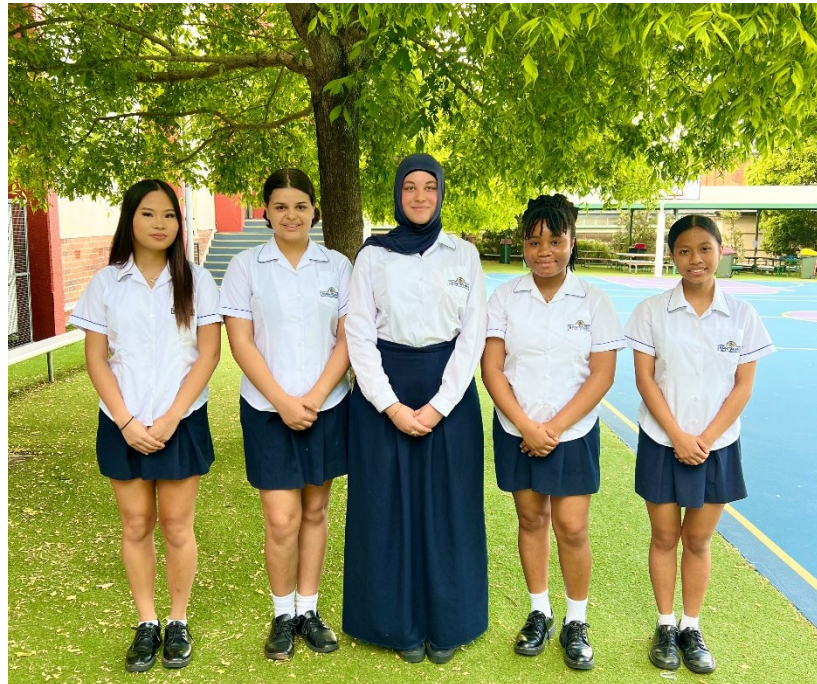
# Procedures for students out of uniform

Students found out of uniform during **ELP will be sent to the Senior Executive immediately** by their teacher.

During the rest of the school day, teachers will deal with uniform infringements and **issue any consequences. Students who do not have a note must be sent to the Senior Executive immediately.**
